

## **POOL RULES**

A person using the pool or pool area does so at his/her own risk and sole responsibility. There is **no lifeguard on duty**. The Management Company and The View M.D., LLC/Parkland Towne Center Development, INC assume no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use. **Pool hours are 7:00AM to 9:00PM** daily, weather permitting, from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The pool will be scheduled to close following the Labor Day Holiday.

A maximum total of six (6) persons per unit – including resident(s) and guest(s) are permitted use of the pool area at any given time. The resident of the unit must be present when guests are using the pool facilities. The resident will be responsible for the actions of his/her guest(s) and will enforce compliance with these rules by each member of his/her family and by his/her guest(s). An adult resident must accompany children under 18 years of age.

- Do not bring food, drink, gum or tobacco into the pool. Smoking is prohibited.
- No glass or shatterable items, excluding eyeglasses are permitted in the pool area.
- Shower before entering the pool and after use of toilet facilities.
- Infants not toilet-trained must wear proper swim diaper at all times. Diaper changing on the pool deck is prohibited.
- The pool gates must be locked at all times when the pool is not open, as specified by the Wisconsin Health Department. At no time will gate be obstructed so as to prevent it from closing, and access to the pool area shall be through gate only.
- Running, jumping, pushing, wresting, ball playing, or causing undue disturbances in or about the pool area will not be permitted.
- Spouting of water and similar unhygienic actions will not be permitted in the pool.

## • NO DIVING!

- Floatation devices and small play equipment may be used only during non-peak times or when 10 or less people are present.
- No wheeled vehicles allowed in the pool area.
- No animals are allowed in the pool area at any time.
- Persons having infections or sores or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharge, or any communicable disease shall not use the pool.
- Persons with open sores or bandages of any kind shall not use the pool.
- Only proper swimming attire is allowed.
- The swimming pool cannot be reserved for private functions.
- No abusive or profane language or breach of the peace will be tolerated.
- Only use the exterior restroom facility designated for pool use.
- Portable chairs are permitted by the pool. You are responsible for lost or damaged items.
